Selected contributors may be invited to submit full papers for a **post-conference edited volume.**

The ClimateXLaw Conference provides an **interdisciplinary platform** for scholars, practitioners, and policymakers to critically examine how legal systems can respond to climate change as a long-term structural challenge rather than a temporary emergency.

The conference aims to **rethink existing legal frameworks** and develop innovative regulatory and governance approaches that support socio-ecological sustainability, climate justice, and resilient legal systems.

Experts from law, environmental science, economics, political science, philosophy, technology studies, and similar disciplines are invited to contribute to a cross-disciplinary dialogue on the future of climate governance.
